

## Buses

Bus routes **493** and **G1** enter the grounds of St George's Hospital. Several other bus routes serve roads within a short walk of the hospital – routes **44**, **77**, **270** and **N44** stop on Garratt Lane, routes **57**, **131**, **219** and **N155** stop on Tooting High Street, and routes **155**, **264** and **280** stop on Blackshaw Road.

 Low-floor, wheelchair accessible buses run on all routes.

## Tube and rail links

**Tooting Broadway** on the Northern line is about a 10 minute walk from the hospital, or a short ride on bus routes **493** or **G1**.

National Rail services from **Tooting** station are linked to the hospital by bus routes **44**, **77**, **264**, **270**, **280** and **N44**.

## Taxis and private hire

Know what you're getting into.

CABWISE is a text message based service that helps you find a taxi or licensed minicab. Simply text HOME to **60835** to get one taxi and two local licensed minicab numbers sent straight to your mobile\*.

## Car parking at St George's Hospital

Pay and display car parking is available at St George's Hospital. The charges are paid on exit, and are as follows:

- £2 for the first hour, with half hourly rates after that
- £20 for six hours or over (daily fixed rate)

Parking concessions may be available, please speak to hospital staff for further information.

Blue badge holders may park free in:

- Any of the reserved disabled spaces available near the entrances of the hospital wings
- Any white-painted bay on the hospital perimeter road
- In the car parks (the badge holder must take the ticket and blue badge to the security desk in Grosvenor Wing before they leave the hospital)

If you need assistance on arrival, e.g. a porter, please contact hospital reception staff.

## Cycles

Free cycle parking facilities can be found at a number of locations on the hospital perimeter road.

## Where to buy your tickets

Oyster is the cheapest way to pay for single journeys on bus, Tube, tram, DLR and London Overground services in London. On your Oyster card, you can store your Travelcard/Bus Pass and/or cash to pay as you go.

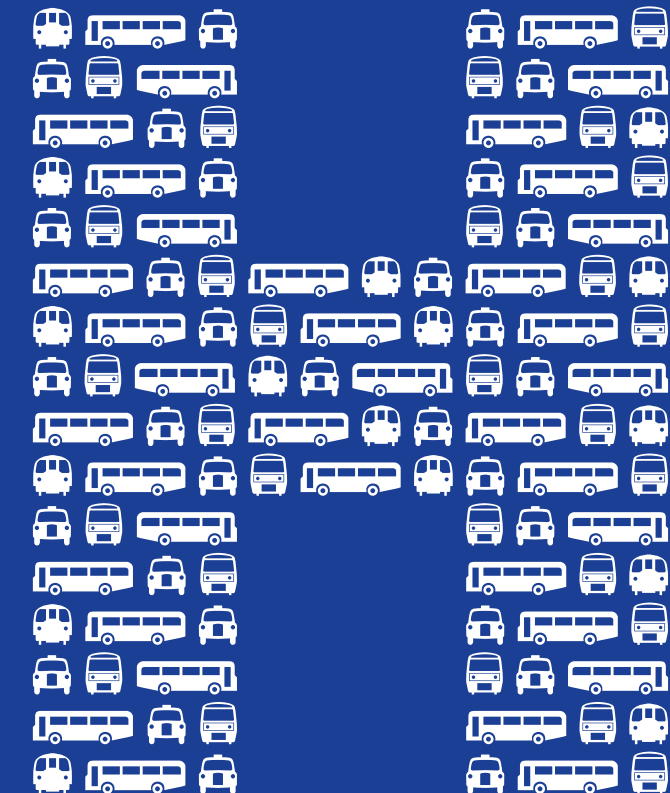

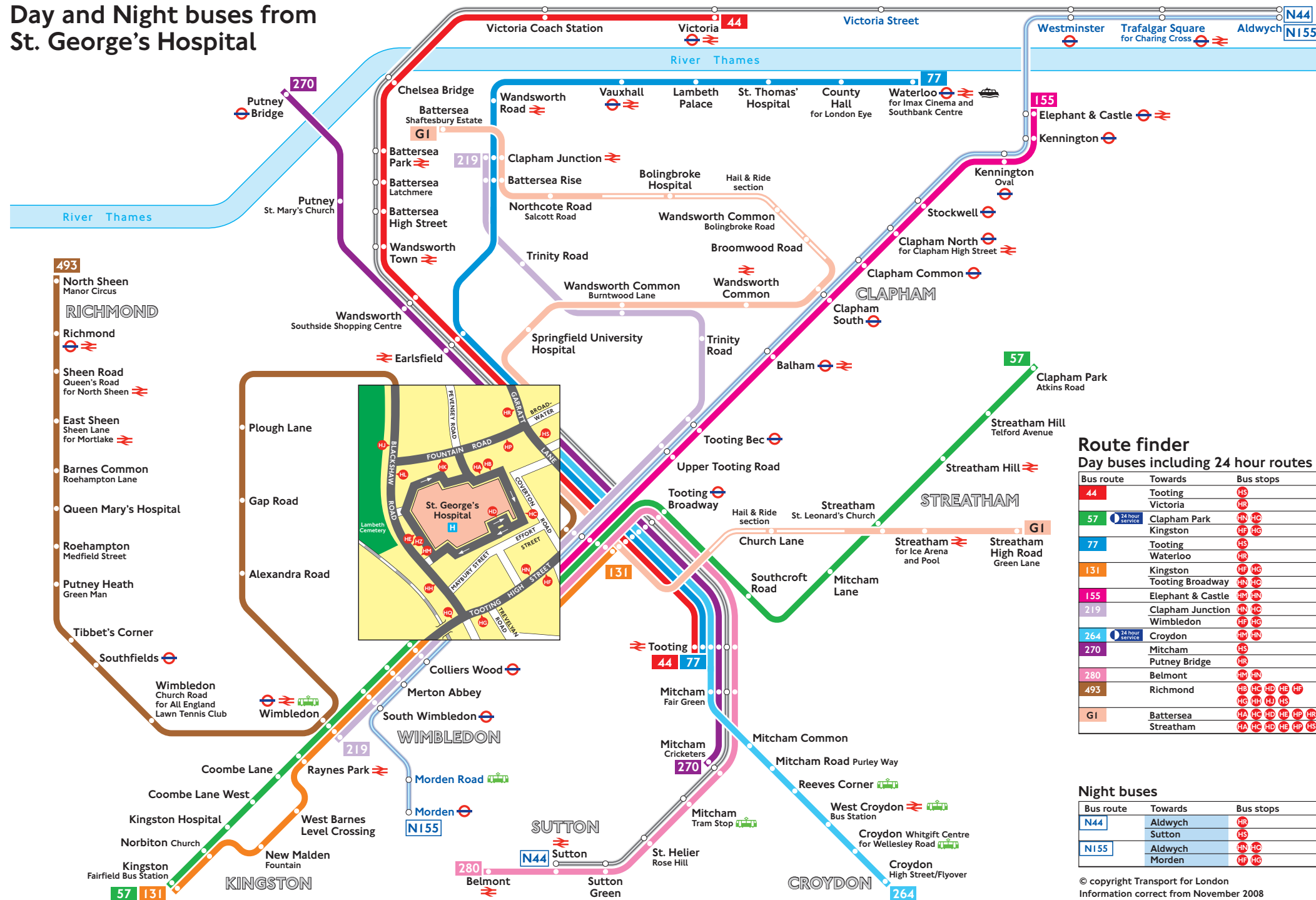
